

## Curriculum Vitae

### **PREDRAG D. JANKOVIĆ**



Mr. Predrag Janković was born on August 17<sup>th</sup>, 1955 in Konari near Smederevo, Serbia.

In 1985, he graduated from the Faculty of Traffic and Transportation, University at Belgrade, at the Department for Railway Traffic and then started his professional career and execution of the most responsible functions on railways:

- 1985 – 1988** worked on expert technical and technological as well as managing functions in the largest shunting station in the country – Belgrade Ranžirna
- 1988 - 2002** executed top managing functions within the Department for Traffic and Operations of the Railway Transport Enterprise Beograd (ŽTP Beograd - Serbian national railway company, at the time)
- 2002 - 2004** worked as the leading engineer for supervision within the company
- 2004 – 2005** worked as Assistant Director General of ŽTP Beograd (now Serbian Railways) for traffic and infrastructure
- 2005 – 2007** worked as Director of Infrastructure Directorate, Serbian Railways
- 2007 – 2009** worked as Advisor within PE “Serbian Railways” in the field of strategy and development of infrastructure and transport projects
- 2009 and on** Mr. Janković has been on the function of Deputy Director General of PE “Serbian Railways” for Infrastructure and Traffic and, at the same time, he is a member of the Executive Board of Directors of the company.

Mr. Janković is a President of the Assembly of the company for construction of Belgrade Railway Node and a member of the National Association of Graduated Engineers of Railway Traffic and he is a member of the Administration Board of the said Association.
