Marijan Klaric



Mr. Marijan Klaric was born on April 24th, 1950.

In 1977 he graduated from the Interfaculty Traffic Engineering Studies at the Faculty of Civil Engineering in Zagreb, after which he started a rich professional career and managed the most responsible affairs at Railways:

- Director of Transport Operations in ŽTP Zagreb (Railway Transport Company);
- Head of Traffic and Transport Service in HŽP (Croatian Railway Company),
- Head of Department for International Relations in HŽ (Croatian Railways).
- In July 1996 he was appointed President of the HŽ Management Board and General Manager, a position he held until 1999.
- From 1999 to 2004 he worked at the Ministry of Maritime Affairs, Transport and Communications as the Transport Minister's Assistant for Railway Transport (1999-2002) and Adviser at the Transport Minister's Office (2002-2004). During that time he was a member of the NATO Committee for Inland Transport. In addition, as a representative of the Republic of Croatia he participated in the process of drawing up of TIRS and REBIS regional studies on transport and transport infrastructure for the region of South-Eastern Europe.
- From 2004 till September 30, 2005, when he was appointed Deputy President of the HŽ Management Board, he was a representative of DB AG in the Republic of Croatia.
- Since the division of Croatian Railways on January 1, 2007, Mr. Klaric has held the position of Managing Director of **HŽ Putnički prijevoz d.o.o.** (HŽ Passenger Transport), and is also a member of the HŽ Holding Management Board.
