

General Assembly Association Korridor X PLUS

Elections for the 2nd Period

Two years after the foundation of the Association Korridor X PLUS a General Assembly took place again on January 28th, 2011 in Vienna on invitation of the Association's President, Mr. Arnold Schiefer. The presentations and inputs at this conference have been listened to with interest and favourably received by the participants. All six member railways were present. Furthermore, Mr. Marios Miltiadou – specialist in the Steering Committee of Pan-European Corridor X – and Mr. Matteo Mussini – representative of CER Brussels – participated.



Secretary General Thomas Wimroither reported on successfully together with his colleague Zorana Đokić performed potential analyses to cut stopping times in passenger and freight transport at the border stations Dobova (Slovenia), Zagreb, Vinkovci/Tovarnik (Croatia) and Šid (Serbia). Until the next General Assembly to be held in June 2011 recommendations for optimising travel and transport times resulting from these analyses shall be compiled in an action plan, which shall be implemented by all members.
