

„Korridor X PLUS” having been founded

Arnold Schiefer, Member of the Executive Board of ÖBB-Railnet Austria Inc. takes over presidency of the recently founded CEE- Rail-Cooperation „Korridor X PLUS“. The members met at the foundation assembly on January 30th, 2009.

„Korridor X PLUS” is managed as an association and replaces ARGE Korridor X. Main objective of this Cooperation is to strengthen team work among Central- and South-Eastern European Railways even more. Special emphasis is placed on making the Corridor more attractive and speeding up transport times. Mr. Schiefer, Board Member of ÖBB-Railnet Austria Inc. and President of “Korridor X PLUS” underlines: “This Corridor is a very important north-south route for Austria and the European Union. With regard to road competition team work among Railways is essential.”

Corridor X runs from Salzburg via Villach to Ljubljana, Zagreb, Belgrade, Niš, Skopje and to Thessaloniki as well as to Sofia (proceeding to Istanbul). Its “branches” cover the routes Graz – Maribor – Zagreb, Budapest – Belgrade, Niš – Sofia, and Skopje – Florina.
